## WRN Broadcast improves digital workflow for Manchester United TV

### Overview

- Manchester United TV (MUTV), the official dedicated Manchester United television channel, distributed worldwide and on Sky and Virgin Media in the UK and Ireland, approached international broadcast services company, WRN Broadcast to develop a new workflow-based solution to improve the storage and delivery of its significant tape archive
- Content included Premier and Champions League football footage, reserve matches, youth team games and training sessions
- MUTV also wanted to create an operational workflow that would improve its productivity and performance at a technical level.

## Solution

- WRN Broadcast undertook a workflow evaluation in order to ascertain the best technology for MUTV's needs and worked with them to develop the most suitable solution.
- WRN Broadcast's content management team received in excess of 2500 broadcast master tapes in multiple formats from MUTV. WRN Broadcast then ingested the tape material into IMX 30 with a QuickTime Wrapper. All encoded assets were then stored within a bespoke digital archive, designed by WRN Broadcast.
- WRN Broadcast also created two LTO4 data tapes for deep archive and disaster recovery purposes.
- In conjunction with WRN Broadcast's partners, the system was then integrated into MUTV's facilities,

and WRN Broadcast instigated a turnkey storage and asset management solution. This system creates low-resolution proxy files that enable MUTV staff to browse the archive and access content from their desktop, edit metadata fields, associate media with assets (e.g. scripts) and edit the material.

### Result

- Workflow has been improved as MUTV's editorial team has access to the digital content library. This has sped up productivity at MUTV, raised the quality of the channel and increased efficiency by reducing tape-handling and time spent in expensive edit suites.
- MUTV subscribers benefit from the availability of additional, reversioned content from the MUTV archives.
