- The technology used includes a state of the art RF system, Pharos MAM, PubliTronic Playout Servers, Evertz Routing and Glue, DDN Storage System Harmonic Electra 8000 Encoders and new Harmonic Pro Stream 1000 multiplexers.
- Four of Zuku's eight movie channels are in HD, showing films from some of the world's most successful studios. Zuku Life (documentary), Zuku Afrika (general entertainment) and Zuku Sports (also in HD) round out the offering.
